1. Report submitted by the State be taken on record.
2. The report dated April 7, 2026 speaks of recovery of the victim. Report states that the victim is a Bangladeshi national and a minor.
3. Police registered a First Information Report being Nimta Police Station Case No. 74 of 2025 dated March 14, 2026 under Sections 140(3)/ 126(2)/ 115(2)/ 117(2)/ 351(2)/ 61(2) of BNS. Police are continuing with the investigations with regard to such police case.
4. On the application of the police, Section 21 of the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 was added to such police case.
5. Since the victim stands recovered and in custody with the Juvenile Justice Board, no further interference is called for in a writ of habeas corpus.

6. WPA (H)/23/2026 is **disposed of** without any order as to costs.
