CRM (NDPS) 477 of 2026

In re : An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with Gangarampur Police Station Case No. 592 of 2023 dated 23.12.2023 u/s 21(c)/22(c)/23(c)/27A/28/29 of the NDPS Act.

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for about 83 days and has been implicated on the basis of statement of a co-accused. Learned advocate added that there is no recovery from the present petitioner and the subject-matter of the case relates to alleged recovery of 293 bottles of phensedyl and 20 bottles of MKDyl.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail as the petitioner was absconding for a long period of time.

However, since there is no recovery from the present petitioner and the learned Special Court is still exhausting the process against the other accused persons, I am of the

view that further detention of the present petitioner is unwarranted.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, **Muzammel Miah** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge under NDPS Act-cum-ADJ, 3rd Court, Dakshin Dinajpur at Balurghat.

If on bail, the petitioner shall also make himself physically available on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special court and shall not leave the district of Dakshin Dinajpur without prior intimation to the learned Special court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 477 of 2026 is **allowed.**
