1. The affidavit of service filed today is kept on record.
2. In spite of service, the School Authority is not represented.
3. The petitioner is an Assistant Teacher since 2013. The petitioner had applied for transfer from the School, for which the School had duly issued 'No Objection Certificate'.
4. The transfer was sought on the self medical ground of the petitioner. The petitioner has also gone through the two-tier medical examination, first by the School and then by the concerned District Inspector of Schools (SE).
5. The respondent no. 5 had thereafter forward her recommendation to the respondent no. 4 sometime in 2022.

6. It appears from the record that the respondent no. 4 has not disposed of such application which is pending since 2022.

7. The respondent no. 4, Secretary, West Bengal Central School Service Commission or any appropriate authority is directed to consider the case of the petitioner and dispose of by July 15, 2026. The Commission will recommend the transfer of the petitioner to a school of her choice, provided such school is not notified for any other competitive examinations.

8. The writ petition is, thus, disposed of.

9. There shall, however, be no order as to costs.
