Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that in the present case the prosecution witnesses itself did not
support its case, although the alleged recovery is of 150 Kgs. of
Ganja. It has been submitted that prosecution has relied upon
23 witnesses, out of which 12 witnesses have been examined.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail and submits that all efforts are being exerted by the State
to conclude the trial at the earliest.

Having considered the quantum of seizure, as a matter
of last chance, I grant 6 months time to the prosecution to
conclude all the witnesses.

With the aforesaid observations, CRM (NDPS) 490 of 2026 is **dismissed**.

Liberty is granted to the State to communicate this order to the learned Trial Court.
