2) Learned advocate representing Mr. Avijit Mondal,
respondent no. 7, being one of the sons of petitioners
has submitted that payment to the tune of Rs.
14,000/- was made in favour of the petitioners on 5th
June, 2026 on UPI in terms of order dated 14th July,
2025 of jurisdictional authority under the Maintenance
and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007
subject to result of revisional application preferred by
respondent no. 7. In support of making payment on 5th
June, 2026 by respondent no. 7 a document is

produced before this Court disclosing UPI transaction ID and same is taken on record.

3) It is submitted by learned advocate representing the petitioners that petitioners have no grievance with regard to payment made by respondent no. 7(a).

4) In view of paying the amount in terms of order dated 14th July, 2025 of jurisdictional authority under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, grievance of the petitioners is found to have been redressed.

5) Hence, no further order need be passed on this writ petition.
