Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody for more than 7 months and
charge sheet has already been submitted, as such further
detention of the present petitioner is unwarranted.

Learned advocate for the State has opposed the prayer
for bail and produced the case diary.

I have taken into account the post-mortem report as
well as the communication of the Doctor to the Officer-in-
Charge of Noapara Police Station. Having regard to the
unfortunate incident and that the petitioner is in custody for

more than 7 months as also the prosecution intends to rely upon 11 witnesses in order to prove its case which will consume some time, I am of the view that further incarceration of the present petitioner is unwarranted. As such the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely, **Jitendra Shaw @ Jitu** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned ACJM, Barrackpore.

If on bail, petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed before the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of 24 Parganas North without the prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 731 of 2026 is **allowed**.
