1. This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of Title Appeal No.187 of 2022 pending before the learned Additional District Judge, 1st Fast Track Court, Lalbagh, Murshidabad.

In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, prior service of the revisional application along with a notice is not being directed, however, the petitioner shall remain obliged to serve a copy of the revisional application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite parties within a week from date.
