1. It is submitted on behalf of the WBSEDCL that a cheque for Rs.53,329/- has been handed over to the petitioner. This fact is admitted by the petitioner.

3. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh suit for any other monetary claim.
4. The question of the validity of the order passed by the Ombudsman dated 1 September 2015 is not gone into.
