Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the subject matter of recovery in the present case relate to
351 Gms. of Heroin and the petitioner is in custody for 1 year 2
months.

Learned advocate has drawn the attention of the Court
to the Chemical Examiner's Report which reflects that
Diacetylmorphine (Heroin), Acetylcodein, 6-
Monoacetylmorphine, Morphine, Codeine & Alprazolam (all are
covered under NDPS Act) and Acetaminophen, Olanzapine & 3-

Hydroxy-2-naphthoyl-ortho-anisidide (all are not covered under NDPS Act) are present.

In ***Sentu Seikh vs. State of West Bengal (SLP (Crl.) No. 13987/2025)*** the Hon'ble Supreme Court was pleased to release the petitioner on bail as quantification was not expressed by the prosecution or the Chemical Examiner.

Having considered the same and the quantity which has been seized in connection with the instant case, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely, **Arijulla Sekh @ Babu** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act, Krishnanagar, Nadia.

If on bail, petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Nadia without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 558 of 2026 is **allowed**.
