1. Matter is taken up for consideration pursuant to the order dated 18th May, 2026 when learned advocate representing respondent no. 3 has submitted that though report is not made ready but relevant documents are lying with the learned advocate for production before this Court for consideration.

However, both the learned advocates representing petitioner and respondent no. 3 have jointly submitted that account of the petitioner lying with IDFC FIRST Bank, Park Street Branch has become operational as it was communicated vide email letter dated 18th May, 2026 by the bank authority.
