1. Affidavit of service filed be kept with the record.
2. The writ application has been preferred praying for direction upon the respondent no.3 to execute the certificate issued by way of corrigendum by the Controlling Authority on 24.06.2025.
3. It is submitted by the petitioner herein that he has received the principal amount of gratuity and the said corrigendum is only in respect of the interest which was left out from the initial certificate due to inadvertence.
4. The petitioner prays for necessary direction upon the Certificate Officer.
5. On hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the materials on record, the writ application is disposed of with the direction that the Certificate Officer being the respondent no.3 shall make all endeavour to dispose of the said
