Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that he seeks to withdraw the revisional application as his remedy lies before the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal since the order impugned is one that has been passed by the House Rent Controller, Malda under Section 21 of the West Bengal Premises Tenancy Act, 1997.
