Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner has been implicated along with others for
alleged recovery of 15 bottles of Phensedyl and is in custody for
225 days. It has also been submitted that similarly situated
accused persons have been granted bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail and submits that the petitioner is similarly situated.

In view of the aforesaid, prayer for bail of the petitioner
is allowed.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely, **Lalu Bhagat @ Lulu Bhakat** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Judge, Special Court cum Additional Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Malda.

If on bail, petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed before the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Malda without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 621 of 2026 is **allowed**.
