Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody for 5 years and 3 months.

Earlier this petitioner approached the Hon'ble Supreme
Court wherein Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No. 14538 of 2024
was passed. There was a direction to conclude the trial by 31st
October, 2025.

Learned advocate for the State submits that the
examination-in-chief of the last witness was completed on 4th
September, 2025 and since then the accused has been
continuing the cross-examination. Presently, the date has been
fixed for examination of the accused under Section 313 of
Cr.P.C.

Having considered the advanced stage of the proceedings, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail having regard to the fact that there was alleged recovery of 26 Kgs. of Yaba Tablets and 2 Kgs. of Heroin.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 623 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
