Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that from the possession of the petitioner, 38 Kgs. of Ganja
were allegedly recovered.

It has been emphasized, petitioner has been falsely
implicated. There are no materials and as charge sheet has
been submitted, petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail.

Having considered the quantum of seizure, I am of the
view that the rigors of Section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted.
As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS)
634 of 2026 is **rejected**.
