In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Alipore** P.S. Case No. **22 of 2026** dated **16.01.2026** under Sections **61(2), 318(4), 127(2), 143(2) and 308(5)** of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits as follows. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The principal accused was arrested and was thereafter granted interim bail.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail. He submits that the petitioner had introduced the alleged victim to the principal accused and it was the principal accused who took money on the promise of giving him a job in a hotel.

Considering the above, the other materials available in the case diary, the alleged role ascribed to the present petitioner and the fact that principal accused was arrested and was thereafter granted interim bail, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in this case and I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner shall cooperate with investigation, shall meet the I.O. once a fortnight till submission of report in final form and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
