C.R.M. (NDPS) 636 of 2026

In Re:- An application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Kaliachak Police Station Case No. 1560/2025 dated 08.09.2025 under Sections 21(C)/25/27A/29 of the NDPS Act.

1. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits although the subject matter of case relates to alleged recovery of 309 grams of brown sugar and Rs.18,27,500/- cash, but so far as the present petitioner is concerned, he has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused. There are no CDRs and money trail so far as the present petitioner is concerned. As such the petitioner may be granted bail on stringent conditions.

2. Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail but is unable to refute the contentions advanced by the learned advocate for the petitioner.

3. Having considered the period of detention and the locus of the present petitioner that there has been no recovery, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

4. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner, namely, **Ansarul Mia @ Kasim Mia** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act-cum-Additional District Judge, 4th Court, Malda. If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned trial court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Malda, without the prior permission of the learned special court.

5. Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 636 of 2026 is allowed.
