CRM (NDPS) 685 of 2026

In re : An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with PTN Case No. 62 of 2026 arising out of Golabari PS Case No. 27 of 2026 dated 29.01.2026 corresponding to T.R. No. 13 of 2026 u/s 20(b)(ii)(B/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the subject-matter of the recovery in the present case is 13.7 kg of ganja. The petitioner is in custody for 82 days and charge-sheet has already been submitted.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Having considered that the quantum of seizure is of intermediate quantity, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, **Md. Arfid Alam** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of

Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Special Court under NDPS Act, Howrah.

If on bail, the petitioner shall also make himself physically available on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court/trial court and shall not leave the district of Howrah without prior intimation to the learned Special Court/trial court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 685 of 2026 is **allowed**.
