An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with English Bazar P.S. Case No.2411 of 2025 dated 25.11.2025 under Section 351(2) of the BNS, 2023.

Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record and kept in a sealed cover.

Report filed by the State is taken on record.

Despite service no one appears on behalf of the de facto complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and relies on the statement of the victim recorded before the learned Magistrate and the statements of her mother, neighbours and school teachers as well as the medical report. He submits that despite several raids, the petitioner could not be apprehended.

Considering the above and the other materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
