An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Raiganj P.S. Case No.88 of 2025 dated 30.01.2025 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/118(1)/118(2)/109/3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

It is the prosecution case that the petitioners and the other assailants not only assaulted the de facto complainant, but also the pregnant wife of the de facto complainant, which resulted in termination of her pregnancy.

Earlier, anticipatory bail applications of similarly circumstanced co-accused were turned down by this Court on 20.03.2025 and on 10.09.2025.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
