Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits as follows. It is alleged that due to previous land dispute, the petitioners entered into the house of the alleged victim and assaulted her. The FIR was registered through a court complaint. The same was lodged sixteen days after the incident. No grievous injury was caused.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the de facto complainant strongly opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State strongly opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail. He relies on the injury report, which, however, does not show infliction of any grievous injury. He relies on the statement of the victim and the other witnesses.

Considering the above and the other materials available in the case diary, although I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the

petitioners , the movements of the petitioner nos. 3, 4, 7 and 8 need to remain restricted for a limited period.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further conditions that the petitioners shall co-operate with the investigation and the petitioner nos. 3, 4, 7 and 8 shall meet the Investigating Officer once a fortnight till submission of report in final form. The petitioner nos. 3, 4, 7 and 8 shall stay outside the jurisdiction of Pukhuria Police Station for a period of four months from this date, except for attending the jurisdictional Court or meeting the Investigating Officer or casting their votes in the ensuing assembly election.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
