Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner was arrested on 17.05.2025 and the subject
matter of the present case relate to recovery of more than 1100
Gms. of Heroin. There are other accused persons also from
whom seizure has been effected. Petitioner emphasizes on the
period of detention.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail.

I have taken into account the quantum of seizure which
is of commercial quantity and is of the opinion, as the rigors of
Section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted, I am not inclined to

release the petitioner on bail. However, the learned Trial Court will split up the trial after exhausting the process of law so far as the absconding accused is concerned.

Consequently, CRM (NDPS) 733 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
