Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for more than two months and has been implicated on the accusation of alleged recovery of 37 bottles of phensedyl.

Additionally, it has been submitted that the petitioner has valid drug licence, inspite of that, he has been detained by the police authorities.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the investigation of the case is in progress.

Having considered the fact that the investigation of the case is in progress, at this stage, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Rejected.**

The petitioner will renew his prayer for bail after the charge-sheet is submitted before the learned jurisdictional court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 690 of 2026 is **Dismissed.**
