- 1.** The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit no. 406 of 2025 from the Court of learned District Judge at Chinsurah to the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Calcutta.
- 2.** On hearing the learned counsels for the parties and on perusal of the materials on record, it appears that the Matrimonial Suit has been filed in the Chinsura Court, by the husband/opposite party herein.

3. The petitioner/wife herein resides at 1/1E, Prem Chand Boral Street, P.S.- Muchipara, Kolkata.
4. Considering the said difficulty of the petitioner/wife to travel to Chinsura, on regular basis, this Court relying upon the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, directs that the Matrimonial Suit no. 406 of 2025 be withdrawn from the Court of learned District Judge at Chinsurah and be transferred to the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Calcutta.
5. Learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Calcutta, shall proceed with the suit in accordance with law with due notice upon both the parties.
6. Keeping in mind the case of the opposite party herein, the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Calcutta, shall be at liberty to permit the opposite party to **appear virtually**, if the such prayer is made.
7. **CO 1270 of 2026 is disposed of.**
