1. This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of Title Suit No.514 of 2016 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court at Howrah.
2. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the suit is for partition and the petitioner is the defendant no.1 in the suit. It is submitted that the suit has been pending since long.
3. In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, prior service of the revisional application along with a notice is not being directed, however, the petitioner shall remain obliged to serve a copy of the revisional application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite parties within a week from date.
4. Having heard the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner and having considered the material on record, this revisional application is disposed of by requesting the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court at Howrah to dispose of Title

Suit No.514 of 2016 as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of eight months from the next date fixed without granting any unnecessary adjournment to any of the parties.

5. With the aforesaid observations, CO 1288 of 2026 stands disposed of. No costs.
