Learned advocate for the petitioner prays for bail on the ground that the chemical examiner’s report do not quantify the ingredients, as such, the petitioner is entitled to bail.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand, points out that the bail application of the petitioner was rejected by the Hon’ble Supreme Court on 02.04.2026 in Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No. 1030 of 2026.

Having considered that the Hon’ble Supreme Court has rejected the prayer for bail of the petitioner very recently, I am of the view that the present application for bail do not require any consideration within a short span of time.
