Mr. Basu, learned Senior Advocate, appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 5th February, 2026 and there has been no recovery from the possession of the present petitioner. Learned Senior advocate also submits that the petitioner is better placed than the other accused person who has been granted bail in CRM (NDPS) 732 of 2026.

Having considered that the petitioner was implicated on the basis of statement of the co-accused; there has been no recovery from the possession of the present petitioner; neither there is any CDR nor any money trial so far as the present petitioner is concerned, I am inclined to enlarge the

petitioner on bail on the same terms and conditions as the other accused person who has been granted bail in CRM (NDPS) 732 of 2026.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 755 of 2026 is **allowed.**
