C.R.M. (NDPS) 767 of 2026

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Gazole Police Station Case No. 1014 of 2024 dated 12.11.2024 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that from the possession of the present petitioner 256 grams of Heroin was recovered and from another accused, 250 grams of Heroin was recovered. So far as the other accused viz. Ratan Debnath is concerned, he has been granted bail on 24.03.2026 in CRM (NDPS) 335 of 2026.

Having considered the reasons assigned while granting bail to other accused in CRM (NDPS) 335 of 2026, I am of the opinion that the same grounds would also apply to the present petitioner. As such, the petitioner viz., **Mahesh Sarkar** be released on bail on the same terms and conditions as the other accused has been granted bail in CRM (NDPS) 335 of 2026.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 767 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
