Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the bail application, the evidence of the prosecution witness is over and date has been fixed for examination of the accused person under Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Ms. Arushi Rathore, learned advocate is directed to represent the State. Her appointment may be regularised by the concerned authorities.

In view of the case being at the advanced stage, I direct that the learned Special Court would put in efforts so that the verdict is pronounced by end of July, 2026.

At this stage, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **rejected.**

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 794 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
