Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that a co-accused, namely, Aurangajeb Mallik @ Lambu has
been granted bail.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the case
diary.

I have taken into account the locus of the present
petitioner as well as the said Aurangajeb Mallik @ Lambu.
Prima facie it reflects, petitioner is better placed than the other
accused who has been granted bail. As such, the prayer for bail
of the petitioner is allowed.

Accordingly, petitioner, namely **Abdul Hamid Sk @ Kuddus**, shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned CJM, Nadia.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed before the Learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Nadia without prior permission of the learned Trial Court. Petitioner shall not enter the jurisdiction of Chapra Police Station without taking permission from the learned Court in seisin of the present case.

With the aforesaid observations CRM (M) 999 of 2026 is **allowed**.

Memo of Evidence submitted by the learned advocate appearing for the State be kept with the record.
