1. It is fairly submitted on behalf of the petitioner that in view of the statutory alternative remedy before the Grievance Redressal Officer, she does not want to proceed any further with this application. In view of the above, WPA 9544 of 2026 stands dismissed.

3. It is made clear that there has been no adjudication on the merits of the case and all issues are left open for the concerned GRO to decide in accordance with law.
