Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the
principle on which another accused has been granted bail in
CRM (NDPS) 506 of 2026 be extended to the present petitioner.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail and submits the Memorandum of Evidence.

Mr. Sagar Saha, learned advocate empanelled with the
Union of India is directed to represent the State. His
appearance may be regularized by the concerned authorities.

Petitioner is in custody for 1 year and 8 months and
only 2 witnesses till date has been examined out of 13
witnesses cited in the charge sheet.

Having considered that other accused persons have been granted bail in CRM (NDPS) 350 of 2026 and CRM (NDPS) 506 of 2026 on the same principle, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Petitioner be released on the same terms and conditions as was imposed upon the accused in CRM (NDPS) 506 of 2026.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 820 of 2026 is **allowed**.

Memo of Evidence filed be kept with the record.
