Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody almost for about 2 years and till
date only 17 witnesses have been examined out of the proposed
22 witnesses. According to the petitioner, the witnesses are not
turning up and stretching the trial of the case, as such, the
petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the case
diary and drawn the attention of the Court to the statement
under Section 183 of the BNSS as also the Medico Legal
Examination Report.

I have taken into account the gravity of the offence and I am of the view that, this is not a fit case for releasing the petitioner at this stage.

Learned Trial Court would take steps so that within a period of 6 months rest of the witnesses are completed by the prosecution.

With the aforesaid observations CRM (M) 1031 of 2026 is **dismissed**.

Mr. Somnath Adhikary, learned advocate was directed to represent the State. His appearance be regularized by the concerned authorities.
