Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits  
that from the custody of the petitioners' along with others, 980  
Gms. of Heroin were recovered. Petitioners are in custody since  
14.06.2025. Charge sheet has already been submitted before  
the jurisdictional Court.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for  
bail.

In view of the quantum of contraband seized, petitioner  
emphasizes on the chemical examiner's report wherein there  
has been no quantification and the contrabands which is

reflected in the chemical examiner's report is Codeine, Morphine and 6-Monoacetylmorphine.

Having considered the quantum the application for bail of the petitioner is rejected at this stage.

Petitioner would renew his prayer for bail after the evidence of the seizure list witnesses is over.

It has been informed that the next date has been fixed on 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 and 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2026. If the seizure list witnesses are not examined on the said date, learned Trial Court would ensure that within a month from the said date efforts are taken for completing the seizure list witnesses.

At this stage, CRM (NDPS) 833 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
