1. The petitioner's application seeking transfer stood rejected by the District Inspector of Schools. Challenging the same, the petitioner approached this Court by filing a writ petition being WPA 8851 of 2022 which stood disposed of on 22nd June, 2022 granting liberty to the petitioner to file fresh application through the online portal.
2. Learned advocate for the petitioner submits, upon instruction that, fresh application was made on 29th June, 2022 in the online portal. However, there is no proof of filing the said application.
3. In view of the above, the instant writ petition stands disposed of with the observation that it will be open for the petitioner to make fresh offline application seeking transfer in the prescribed format disclosing ground for the same.

4. In the event such an application is made, the same shall be considered by the head of the institution in accordance with the prevailing transfer rules.
5. Steps shall be taken in the matter at the earliest but positively within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the application from the petitioner.
6. If the application of the petitioner is allowed, then necessary consequential steps shall be taken without any further delay.
7. The fate of the petitioner's application shall be made known to the petitioner.
8. Suspension of the Utsashree portal will not stand in the way of the respondents to consider the application for transfer made by the petitioner.
9. The writ petition stands disposed of.
10. Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties upon compliance of all requisite formalities.
