In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Sagarpara Police Station Case No. 1004 of 2025 dated 10.11.2025 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of alleged recovery of 200 bottles of Choco/Codeine Phosphate. Petitioner is in custody for eight months and although charge-sheet has been submitted, but till date charges have not been framed.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

The charge-sheet reflects that there are 14 witnesses to be examined. As till date charges have not been framed and trial would take some time, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Saif Sarkar** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with

two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under the NDPS Act, Berhampore, Murshidabad.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Murshidabad without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Memo of Evidence submitted by the learned advocate appearing for the State be kept with the record.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 911 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
