Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the other accused person namely, Bappa Naskar @
Shankar Naskar has been granted bail and petitioner is
similarly placed as the person who has been granted bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail but is unable to refute the contention as to the petitioner
being similarly placed as the other accused person who has
been granted bail.

In view of the aforesaid, the petitioner be released on
the same terms and conditions as was imposed upon the other
accused person, namely, Bappa Naskar @ Shankar Naskar

while he was released on bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Thus, CRM (NDPS) 859 of 2026 is **allowed**.
