The petitioner challenges an order dated April 26, 2024, passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barasat, North 24 Parganas, in G.R. Case No.195 of 2010 whereby a warrant of arrest was issued against the petitioner in connection with Amdanga Police Station Case No.24 of 2010 dated 20.01.2010 under Section 399/402 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

It appears that on February 2, 2026 learned Magistrate fixed June 26, 2026 for execution report.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that the petitioner is willing to surrender before the learned Magistrate.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the warrant of arrest issued against the petitioner is stayed for a period of one month from the date of this order, subject to the condition that

the petitioner shall surrender before the learned Magistrate within the said period.

In the event the petitioner surrenders before the learned Magistrate, any application for bail filed by him shall be considered and decided in accordance with law without being influenced by this order.

In the event the petitioner fails to surrender in terms of this order within the stipulated period, the warrant of arrest shall stand revived automatically, and the learned Magistrate shall be at liberty to execute the same in accordance with law.

Accordingly, **CRR 1850 of 2026** is disposed of.
