In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Goalpokher Police Station Case No. 398 of 2025 dated 27.06.2025 under Sections 21(c)/25/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was initially arrested and alleged recovery of 642 grams of Heroin was foisted upon the present petitioner. There was subsequent recovery of 339 grams from another accused who has been released on bail on 22.04.2026 in CRM(NDPS) 664 of 2026.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

I find that the principle on which the other accused has been granted bail in CRM(NDPS) 664 of 2026 too also apply in respect of the present petitioner. Accordingly, the present petitioner viz., **Abdul Malek @ Md Malek @ Malek** be released on bail by the learned Trial Court on the same terms and conditions as the other accused who has been granted bail in CRM (NDPS) 664 of 2026.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 889 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
