In Re : An Application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Kaliachak Police Station Case No. 1776 of 2024 dated 04.11.2024 under Sections 21(c)/25/27A/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is similarly situated as other accused person viz. Malek Sk who has been granted bail on 15.05.2026 in CRM (NDPS) 819 of 2026.

Mr. Somnath Adhikary, learned advocate, empanelled with the Union of India, is directed to represent the State. His appointment may be regularised by the concerned authorities.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the case diary along with Memo of Evidence.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail, but is unable to refute the contentions of the petitioner that similarly placed accused person has been granted bail.

Having regard to the fact that the petitioner is similarly situated as the other accused viz. Malek Sk who has been

granted bail on 15.05.2026 in CRM (NDPS) 819 of 2026, I am of the opinion that the present petitioner viz., **Imrul Kayesh @ Md. Imrul Kayesh** be released on bail on the same terms and conditions as the other accused who has been granted bail in CRM (NDPS) 819 of 2026.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 902 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.

Memo of Evidence submitted on behalf of the State be kept with the record.

Case diary be returned to the learned advocate appearing for the State.
