6. Considering the difficulty of the petitioner/wife to travel to Barasat Court on regular basis, this Court relying upon the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, directs that Matrimonial Suit No.850 of 2025 be withdrawn from the Court of Learned District Judge, Barasat and be transferred to the Court of Learned District Judge, Krishnanagar.
7. Learned District Judge, Krishnanagar shall proceed with the suit in accordance with law with due notice upon both the parties.
8. Keeping in mind the case of the opposite party herein, the learned District Judge, Krishnanagar shall be at liberty to permit the opposite party to **appear virtually**, if such prayer is made.
