In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023/ Section 439 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure, 1973 in connection with Nabagram Police
Station Case No. 576 of 2024 dated 29th November, 2024 under
Section 20(b)(ii)(C)/25/28/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that although 1 year and 8 months have passed, there has
been no progress in the case. Charge sheet has been submitted
and the petitioner has been implicated on the accusations of
alleged recovery of 102.9 Kgs. of Ganja.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail on the ground of huge recovery.

Having considered the quantity of contraband, I am not
inclined to release the petitioner on bail. However, the Court
cannot keep an accused for an indefinite period of time. As
such, learned Special Court is directed to split up the trial of

the case and proceed with the witness action after framing of charge.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1098 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
