CRM (NDPS) 1243 of 2026

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with NDPS Case no. 37 of 2024, corresponding to NCB Crime No. 02/NCB/SLG/2024 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the NDPS Act read with Section 8(c) of the NDPS Act.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the subject matter of the case relate to alleged recovery of 1.9 kg of heroin. Till date only one witness has been examined by the prosecution and the petitioner is in custody for two years two months.

None appears for the Narcotics Control Bureau.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner, I direct the learned Special Court in seisin of the case to pass necessary directions upon the Superior Officer so that evidence of the seizure list witnesses are concluded within a period of six months from the date of communication of this order.

Petitioner will renew his prayer for bail after the aforesaid time period is over.

At this stage, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS) 1243 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
