- 1) Matter is heard in presence of learned advocates representing the petitioner, State respondents and respondent no. 3.
- 2) Grievance of the petitioner is though a criminal prosecution was initiated being English Bazar Police Station Case No. 1704 dated 19th November, 2024 under sections 406/420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 but same has not been taken to its logical conclusion on completing investigation.
- 3) Petitioner prays for direction upon the concerned police authorities for concluding the investigation.

4) Having considered the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, State respondents and respondent no. 3, writ petition is disposed of thereby directing the concerned police authority to expedite the investigation in connection with English Bazar Police Station Case No. 1704 dated 19th November, 2024 and submit a report at an early.

5) However this order shall not preclude the petitioner to approach the jurisdictional Magistrate, if occasion so arises.
