1. By filing the instant writ petition, the writ petitioner alleged inaction and/or non-action on the part of the police authorities regarding his complaint dated 20.05.2026, as has been sent through mail.

2. It is settled position of law that for non-registration of the F.I.R. on the basis of a complaint, a writ petition is not maintainable. Such view was taken by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Sakiri Vasu v. State of U.P. [(2008) 2 SCC 409 : (2008) 1 SCC (Cri) 440]*** and ***Sudhir Bhaskarrao Tambe Vs.***

Hemant Yashwant Dhage and Others
reported in (2016) 6 SCC 277.

3. In view of the aforementioned observations, the instant writ petition is dismissed as not maintainable.
