Heard the submission of the learned advocates for the petitioner, prosecution as well as the de facto complainant and perused the materials on record. Considering the nature of allegation against the present petitioner and extent of his complicity in the alleged incident and even the evidence as has been adduced by the de facto complainant, this Court is not inclined to enter into the merits of the case. Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances as well as the seriousness of the accusation and merely on the ground of prolonged

incarceration, this Court is not inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands rejected.
