1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Learned advocate representing the petitioner submits that based on complaint lodged with the concerned police authority criminal prosecution was initiated being Deganga P.S. Case No.397 of 2026 dated 12th June, 2026 under certain provisions of BNS, 2023.
