Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of
co-accused and is in custody for about 3 months. The principal
accused is already on statutory bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail. Records reflect petitioner has been implicated on the basis
of statement of the co-accused and the charge sheet refers to
13 witnesses.

Considering the time which will be consumed for taking
the trial to its logical conclusion, I am inclined to release the
petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely, **Paritosh Mahata @ Mahato** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Judge, Special Court (under NDPS Act), 3rd Court, Balurghat, Dakshin Dinajpur.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed before the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Dakshin Dinajpur without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Thus, CRM (NDPS) 1258 of 2026 is **allowed**.
