Mr. Bhattacharjee, learned Senior Standing Counsel raised an objection as to the entertainability of this writ petition in view of the alternative and efficacious remedy available under the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal, 1997.

After some argument, Mr. Chatterjee, learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner, prays for leave to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to approach the appropriate forum in accordance with law.
