The petitioner was appointed as Secretary of Kedarhat Gram Panchayat and superannuated on 28th February, 2013. Despite completing all pension related formalities within due time, pension payment order was issued by the concerned authority on 13th August, 2018. The gratuity amount was disbursed on 1st September, 2018. The petitioner seeks interest on the gratuity amount paid to him due to delay in disbursement of the same.

Upon consideration of the submission made on behalf of the parties and material on record, the Director of Pension, Provident Fund and Group Insurance, Government of West Bengal and the Treasury Officer, Khatra, being the 2nd and 4th respondents herein, are directed to pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 8% per annum on the gratuity calculated from 1st March, 2013 till the date of actual

payment. Such payment shall be made within one month from the date of communication of this order.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit has been invited, allegations contained in the writ petition shall be deemed not to have been admitted.
